SUMMARY

The incumbent is responsible for mowing highway right of way and all public grounds.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Mows all city owned property and rights of way.
2. Performs operator maintenance on equipment.
3. Fog for mosquitoes, spray insecticide and pesticide in city facilities.
4. Spray right of ways and other areas needed for weed and lawn control.
5. Perform light carpenter and light plumbing work.
6. Operates larger tractors, slope mower, backhoe, ten wheel dump truck, loader, track hoe and welder for equipment and fences.
7. Assists Operator I as needed.
8. Perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

High school diploma or general education degree (GED) required. Six (6) months related experience and/or training preferred.

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Ability to read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating and maintenance instructions, and procedure manuals. Must have the ability to write routine reports.

INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL COMMUNICATION

Majority of contacts with immediate associates only. Minimal contact with the public. Must be able to maintain a cooperative working relationship with other departments and personnel of the city.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS

Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers, common fractions, and decimals.

REASONING ABILITY

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out detailed but uninvolved written or oral instructions. Ability to deal with problems involving a few concrete variables in standardized situations.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS

Must have a valid Oklahoma driver's license with driving record suitable to the City's insurance carrier. Must have a CDL or be able to obtain within first six (6) months of employment. Must have the following applicator licenses: general pest, structural pest, ornamental and turf, public health and right of way applicator license.
